

The Jurassic Coast & Glorious East Devon

Monday 29th April to Friday 3rd May

Join us as we return to the fascinating little regency town of Dawlish, which is huddled attractively between steep surrounding hills. There are several popular beaches here including Dawlish Warren - a popular destination in its own right. Meanwhile in the middle of the town there is a flat landscaped area called 'The Lawn', home to various wildfowl and the famous Dawlish black swans. Our tour includes a River Cruise, a ride aboard the Seaton Tramway and a visit to Bicton Park Botanical Gardens.

YOUR HOLIDAY ITINERARY

Monday From your front door to the waiting Club Class coach for the relaxing drive to East Devon, arriving late afternoon. A drinks reception is held each evening preceding dinner.

Tuesday Departing our hotel after breakfast, our first activity today is a gentle cruise on the River Exe. Next, we head to the coastal resort of Torquay where we have time to look around, explore the harbour and the town centre. In the afternoon we make the short journey around the bay to pretty Brixham with its busy harbour and quaint narrow streets.

Wednesday A leisurely breakfast this morning before we visit the Seaton Tramway for a return journey. We travel alongside the River Axe estuary through two scenic nature reserves. Now, back on board the coach and off to our next destination, the historic coastal town Sidmouth. It was Sidmouth that captivated the Poet Laureate, John Betjeman, and it will captivate you too! Beautiful gardens and leisurely walks, Regency history, clean beaches and friendly shops... it's all here in this lovely seaside town that nestles beneath majestic red cliffs and the green hills of the glorious Sid Valley. Later we visit the Famous Donkey Sanctuary. The history of how this was set up is amazing you can listen to the talks explaining all about the sanctuary and how they work with other countries all over the world.

Thursday Today we visit Bicton Park and Botanical Gardens - a unique collection of trees and flowers from all over the world. The Palm House contains many rare Palms, the Tropical House has exotic blooms and the Arid House features some of the world's strangest plants. Take a stroll around or catch the on site train which travels around the beautiful gardens. We return to our hotel for free time in Dawlish before joining again this evening for our final dinner.

Friday After breakfast we depart the hotel and begin our journey home with fond memories of East Devon.

Isle of Man – The Treasured Isle

Monday 6th to Saturday 11th May (6 Days)

EARLY BOOKING RECOMMENDED

Once again, it gives us pleasure to offer our hugely popular Isle of Man holiday. The Isle of Man is an ancient Viking Kingdom which has never been part of the U.K and who's well known three legged emblem originates from a symbol used on 10th century coins. Reminders of the Island's turbulent past abound, Iron Age hill forts, the ruins of Rushden Abbey and the castle at Peel can be seen around the island. The Island's coastline ranges from quiet secluded coves to busy harbours and clean sandy beaches. Our chosen resorts are Douglas - with its Victorian seafront and long promenades, and Ramsey – the second largest town on the island with a lovely harbour still in daily use and a beach for the sun seekers.

YOUR HOLIDAY ITINERARY

Day 1 Our door to door service takes you from your home to the waiting Club Class coach for the drive to Heysham. We board the afternoon ferry to Douglas and on to our hotel, arriving early evening in time for dinner.

Day 2 A relaxing morning in our resort before we join the electric railway to visit Laxey, home of 'Lady Isabella' the world's largest working waterwheel and an icon of the Island's mining history. Later we take a ride on the Snaefell Mountain Railway affording wonderful views from the summit.

Day 3 We are joined by a local guide for a full day tour around the island. We visit Ramsey then Bride, final resting place of the great comedian and Manx resident Norman Wisdom before spending time in Peel with its small harbour and ancient castle, then St Johns, home of the ancient Manx parliament. Our return includes the lofty South Barrule road.

Day 4 A full day tour to the south of the Island crossing the Fairy Bridge to Castletown, the ancient capital, then the viewpoint at the Calf of Man before time in the popular Edwardian resort Port Erin overlooked by Bradda Head, returning by the wonderful narrow gauge Isle of Man Railway.

Day 5 A day at leisure in our chosen resort.

Day 6 After an early breakfast we board the morning ferry from Douglas to Heysham. With suitable stops, we return to our home area and waiting taxis early evening.

Please Note: the 5 day July departure does not include Day 5.

Romantic Ribble Valley

Monday 6th to Friday 10th May

Time appears to have bypassed this historic area, leaving it immersed in rich heritage. We explore the open green land that inspired J.R.R Tolkien's 'Middle Earth'. Surrounded by unspoilt countryside, we explore the canals and historic buildings that fill the Ribble Valley.

Monday From your front door to the waiting Club Class coach for the drive north to reach the Foxfields Hotel late afternoon for tea/coffee & biscuits. We have time to settle in before enjoying dinner this evening.

The Hall was built in 1512 and is the ancestral home of the Parker family. A guided tour is included. This afternoon we have a short drive to Riley Green Marina where we board a canal boat for a relaxing cruise along the canal with included afternoon tea. We make our way back to the hotel late afternoon for dinner.

Wednesday Today we have a full day guided tour of Pendle Hill Country an area made famous by the 17th century trial of the Witches of Pendle. The picturesque village of Downham was used for many film locations including 'Whistle Down the Wind'. We visit Barrowford Visitor Centre before spending time in Clitheroe. Our tour continues with a drive through the Britain in Bloom award winning village of Chipping into the Hodder Valley with a break at the riverside tearooms in Slaidburn.

Thursday A morning drive along the Ribble Valley then north to the historic city of Lancaster where we visit the Ashton Memorial in Williamson Park to learn of its romantic history then have time to explore in the city centre. Our return drive is through the beautiful but sparsely populated Trough of Bowland arriving at the hotel with time to relax before our final night's dinner.

Friday After breakfast we depart for home enjoying a relaxing drive through the wonderful Peak District. We reach our home area to be greeted by our awaiting taxis mid-afternoon.



Treasures of the Rhine featuring Bruges

Tuesday 23rd to Tuesday 30th July

The River Rhine is the main artery of Europe, a truly romantic waterway. Due to popular demand, our holiday begins with an overnight stay and gentle exploration of beautiful Bruges, then, joining our cruise to take us south from Cologne into France with visits to Germany's delightful 'Black Forest', the picture book town of Rudesheim and the 'European City' of Strasbourg. We stay aboard a tried and tested, 4 star ship offering that little bit extra on a holiday combining the relaxing and peaceful style of a river cruise, where you can just sit back and enjoy the breath-taking scenery of fairytale castles and vine-clad slopes with blends of ancient and modern towns, quaint wine villages and an ever-changing panorama.

YOUR HOLIDAY ITINERARY

Tuesday A leisurely start takes us to Dover for the midday crossing to Calais. Now, just the short journey to beautiful Bruges in Belgium, where we find our overnight hotel, the centrally located, 4 star Raddisson Blu, just a 5 minute walk from the city centre. We enjoy free time in this visually stunning medieval city before this evening's dinner.

Wednesday A leisurely breakfast before our included scenic canal cruise, taking in such famous sights as the Beguinage, St Johns Hospital, the Church of Our Lady, the beautiful Belfry and much more. Early afternoon we set off for Cologne to join our river cruiser, the DCS Amethyst Classic. We have time to settle into cabins before this evening's festivities begin with a Welcome Cocktail which is followed by dinner whilst we set off for vibrant Rudesheim.

Thursday Early morning, we cruise through the most well-known stretch of the historic river, the Rhine gorge. We pass the Lorelei Rock where the legendary siren lured sailors to their doom. Dotted amongst the wonderfully tendered vineyards are many ancient castles and fortresses such as Burg Rheinfells. Mid-morning we arrive in the pretty town of Rudesheim. This popular winemaking town is best known for the 'Drosselgasse', a narrow cobblestone street lined with a host of beautifully decorated wine taverns and courtyards with a wonderful atmosphere. We include a visit to the towering Niederwald Monument and entrance to Siegfried's Mechanical Music Museum. Back on board we enjoy dinner and entertainment.

Friday Overnight the ship has made its way to the historic city of Speyer. Ashore we make a walking tour to the city's main square for the magnificent 11th century cathedral, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, one of the Holy Roman Empires most exquisite monuments and Germany's most beautiful crypts. We also include a visit to the famed historic city of Heidelberg overlooked by its dramatic castle.

Saturday Another overnight sailing has brought us to Strasbourg. After a leisurely breakfast we join the coach for a short tour of the 'City of Europe' then take a scenic drive to a picturesque Alsace wine village to enjoy free time and possibly sample some of the local wine. On returning to our ship, we depart late evening for an overnight sailing to Breisach in the Black Forest with dinner served on board.

Sunday Today, we will visit the beautiful 'Black Forest' town of Frieberg. Located at the foot of the Black Forest's wooded slopes and vineyards, Freiburg is a sunny, cheerful university town, its medieval Altstadt a story-book tableau of gabled townhouses, cobblestone lanes and cafe-rimmed plazas. We travel back to our cruiser to enjoy dinner and entertainment on board. Our cruise continues overnight.

Monday Early afternoon we arrive in our final port - the fine Roman city of Mainz. Surrounded by vineyards and an abundance of nature, it's a romantic old place with beautiful half-timbered houses and medieval market squares. The city was home to Johannes Gutenberg, inventor of the modern printing press and the museum bearing his name, contains exhibits of his work and life. Tonight, we enjoy a farewell drinks reception followed by our final dinner on board as we cruise back through the Rhine Gorge to Cologne.



Tuesday A final breakfast on board before disembarking and retracing the steps of our outward journey back to Calais and the return short sea crossing to Dover. We arrive back in our home area early evening after a most memorable Rhine Cruise.


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
